## Whip It Out Instructions – Modulus Speed Belts and Belt Packs.

The Whip It Out lens case is designed to easily be attached to the Modulus Speed Belts, and Think Tank Belt Backpacks. It can be attached so that it will rotate freely, or be locked in place.

**Important Note:** This is designed for a 70-200 2.8, 80-200 2.8, 100-400, or similar size lens upside down in the bag, with the lens hood up, for the fastest retrieval of the lens. This product cannot be used with a Tripod Collar. If you would like to keep the Tripod Collar attached, then use the Lens Changer 75 lens case.



**Step 1:** Release the hook and loop flap on the back of the bag, and wrap it around the belt.



**Step 2:** Reattach the hook and loop flap to the bag, and wrap the flaps securely around the side of the bag.



**Step 3:** To secure the lens in the case, pull the self-locking zipper slider to the top of the bag.



**Step 4:** For additional security pull the cord and adjust the cord lock to the desired fit.



**Step 5:** To "Rotate" or "Lock" the component on the waistbelt, follow the separate instructions.



**Step 6:** Seam-sealed raincover on the inside can be pulled over entire bag and lens hood.

## CAUTION – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY



Picking up the Pro Speed Belt or the Speed Belt Packs up off any surface with the lens still in the Whip it Out may cause the lens to fall out.



Slinging the Pro Speed Belt or the Speed Belt Packs over your shoulder with the lens still in the Whip it Out may cause the lens to fall out.

**CAUTION:** We recommend that you transport the lens in the Whip It Out case only when the case is attached to a Pro Speed Belt or a Modulus Belt Pack that is secured around your waist. Put the lens in the case **AFTER** the Pro Speed Belt or the Modulus Belt Pack is secured around your waist and take it out **BEFORE** removing the Pro Speed Belt or the Modulus Belt Pack from your waist. This will provide the best support for the lens.

**TEST THE FIT** of your lens prior to use. When the zipper is fully zipped up, and with the cord adjusted, it should be very snug, and not fall out. If your lens is too loose, do not use the bag.
